

SAFEGUARDING FLOWCHART: What to do, by whom and by when -

A Safeguarding concern is reported, or identified, by someone within the parish or anonymously

YES

Is the Child/Adult at Immediate Risk?

NO

If the person is at immediate risk of physical harm or needs medical attention, dial 999 to contact the Ambulance Service and/or the Police, and follow the advice given. As soon as possible (but within 24hrs) follow the reporting and recording process in green on the right.

Concern about a member of the clergy or church officer

Concern about a member of the congregation or a child

Inform the Parish Clergy, and the PCC Safeguarding Officer, who will

Record the concern (who, what, when, where, why, how?) within 24hrs of an issue having been raised, and file it securely in the parish office. Send a copy to the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser.
