Since the recycling facility was set up, the ability to recycle certain items has either become easier for you, the consumer, or harder for us, the people responsible for this facility. Therefore, we have had to make a few changes - we hope that you understand.

PLEASE NO	ALTERNATIVE
Blister packs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Small quantities can be dropped off at the <b>Superdrug in the Mall in Salisbury</b>. Any Superdrug with a pharmacy will accept them.</li> <li>• All foil-lined ones can go in with your household recycling.</li> </ul>
Foil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This can go in with your <b>household recycling</b>.</li> <li>• <b>Somerley tip</b> or <b>Morrisons</b> have bins especially for foil.</li> </ul>
Batteries (all types)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Any shop that sells over 32kg</b> of them a year will have a container that you can drop them into.*</li> <li>• They can also be taken to <b>Somerley tip</b>.</li> </ul> <p>*<b>Note:</b> Woodgreen Community Shop <b>DOES NOT</b> meet the required threshold to enable them to register and arrange recycling.</p>
Coloured plastic milk bottle tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Put the tops back on the bottles, and put into your <b>household recycling</b>.</li> </ul>
Corks	Maybe a local school or craft group/person might like them?
Lightbulbs	Take to <b>Somerley tip</b> or <b>B&amp;Q</b> .

Foil-lined crisp packets (or take to the Gourmet grocer in Fordingbridge)	Water filter cartridges (or take to <b>Tesco</b> or <b>Marks and Spencer</b> )
Used stamps	Inkjet cartridges
Spectacles/glasses (or drop off at any Opticians where you buy them)	Foreign coins
Knitting wool	Paper egg boxes (NOT plastic)
Unwanted raffle prizes
